This coming year we will have a changing board along with our President. It's good to see some new members come aboard and get their feet wet in the workings of the Club.

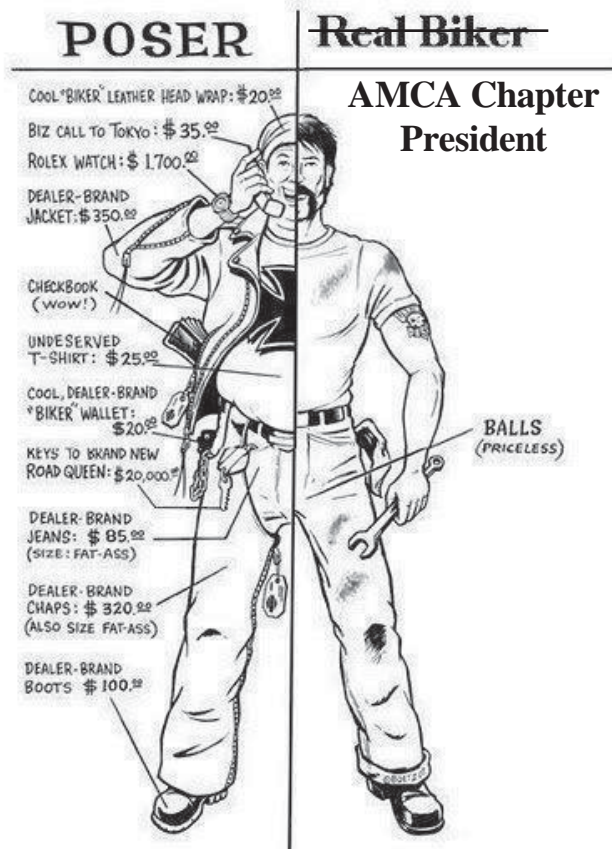
As you will see there will be some changes this coming year. Some due to budget and others due to catching up with the times.

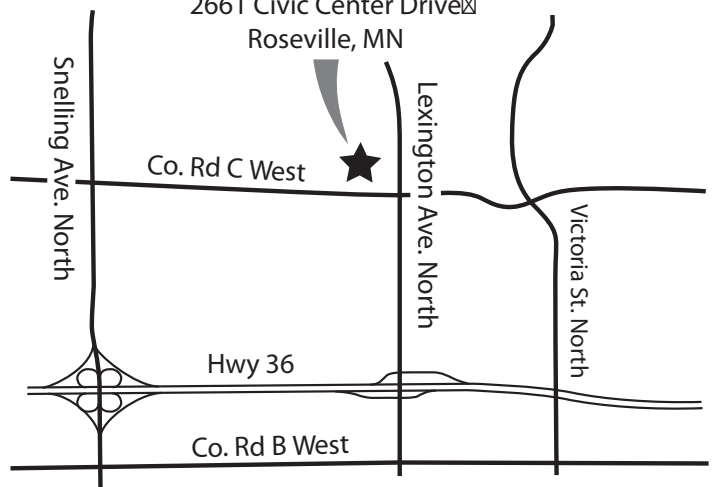

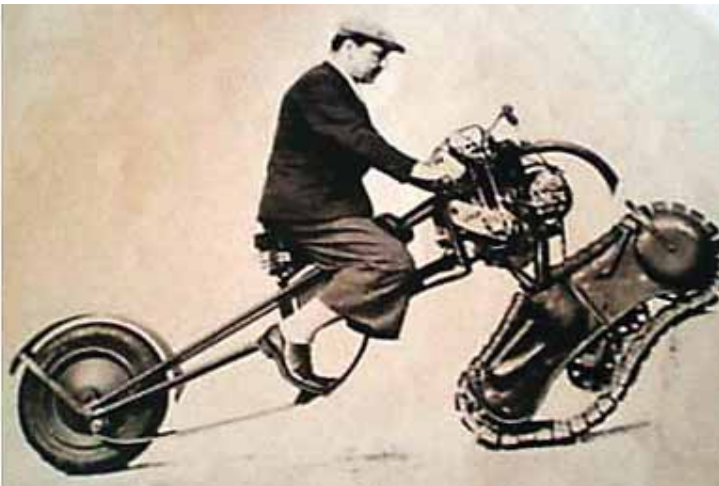

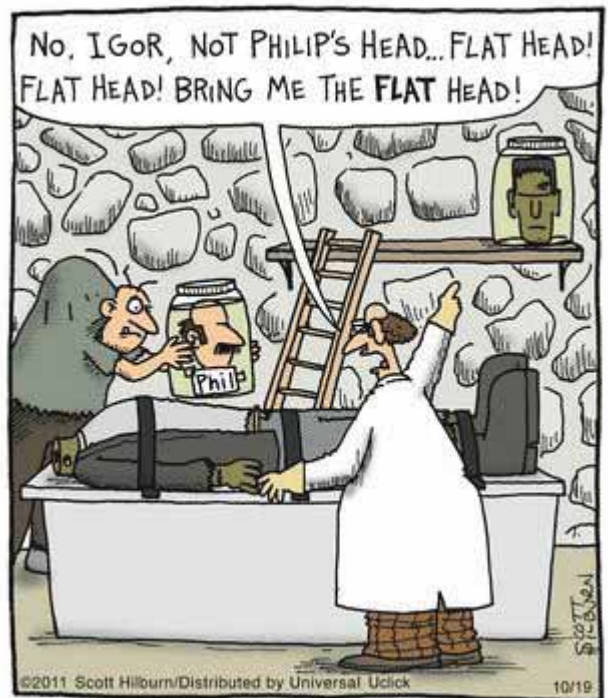

Build Your Own Motorcycle Lift

Build Your Own Motorcycle Lift

This is a 16-hour, two-day course for the intermediate and experienced non-professional welding enthusiast who desires to build their own motorcycle lift or table lift. This is an excellent opportunity to build your project over two consecutive Saturdays in our fully equipped welding lab.

Applications available include SMAW, FCAW, GMAW GTAW, and oxyacetylene torch cutting and welding. This class reinforces safe welding procedures. Then students work independently on their own projects. Instructors will be on hand to assist if required.

Prerequisite: Completion of any MCTC welding class, qualification from another approved welding course, or instructor permission.

Note: Students must provide their own personal safety equipment including ear plugs, safety glasses, protective clothing, etc. as well as their own metals (steel, aluminum, etc.) larger projects such as the table lift, may be stored across the street in the carpentry garage.
